The European Institute of Oncology (IEO: <http://www.iew.it>) is one of Europe's most influential cancer research Institutes. The IEO operates as a Comprehensive Cancer Center, linking fundamental and applied research to clinical activities, patient care and clinical trials. The basic science Department is composed of ~250 scientists, 17 independent research groups and two dedicated scientific programs (Drug Discovery and Molecular Medicine).

IEO also provides postgraduate education through the European School of Molecular Medicine (SEMM: <http://www.semm.it>) with PhD courses in Molecular Oncology, Computational Biology, Medical Nanotechnology and Foundations & Ethics of the Life Sciences, as well as an International postdoc programme. The working and teaching language at IEO and SEMM is English.

The basic science Department of IEO is seeking junior Group Leaders working in any research area related to **basic cancer biology**, based on either experimental or computational technologies.

Successful applicants will be recruited under a **seven year Tenure Track scheme** and will receive a competitive salary and start-up grant for personnel and research expenses.

The applications must include:

2. Concise description of previous achievements and current research interests
3. Future research plan (four pages max)
4. Name and e-mail address of at least three referees.

Applications from senior scientists will also be welcome.
